



# Enhancement Millage

## INFORMATION REGARDING THE NOVEMBER 6, 2018 REGIONAL BALLOT PROPOSAL

### QUICK FACTS

- On Nov 6, 2018, voters in each of the 11 public school districts and 7 public school academies within OAISSD will be asked to consider an enhancement millage proposal of 0.9 mill for 10 years.
  - A majority of voters in the OAISSD would need to approve the proposal for it to be successful.
  - An enhancement millage is the only option for school districts to request operational funding from the public beyond funding provided by the State (after the passage of Proposal A in 1994), and funding derived from the levy of up to 18 mills on non-homestead property in each public school district.
  - Since 2008-09, State funding has not kept up with inflation causing districts to reduce or eliminate programs, classroom materials and staff. See foundation grant comparison chart below.
  - If approved, each of the 11 school districts and 7 public school academies in OAISSD would receive an additional \$226 per student for operations starting with the 2019-2020 school year.
- If approved, Innocademy would receive approximately \$80,000 annually for the next 10 years. Examples of how the money could be allocated include mental health support staff & facility upgrades.

*The OAISSD enhancement millage proposal is for 0.9 mills which is equal to 90 cents for \$1,000 taxable value on a home.*

Home Value	Taxable Value	0.9 Enhancement Millage Calculation
\$100,000	\$50,000 or less	$50 \times 0.9 = \$45$
\$200,000	\$100,000 or less	$100 \times 0.9 = \$90$
\$300,000	\$150,000 or less	$150 \times 0.9 = \$135$
