



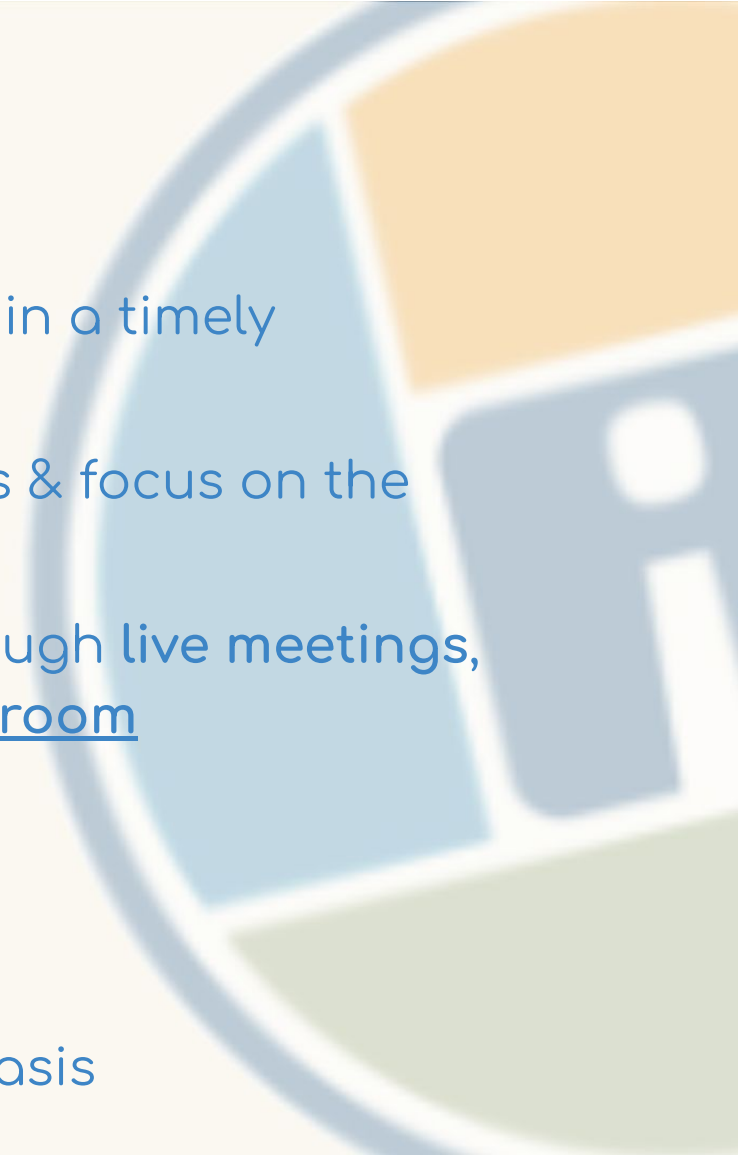
School, Teacher, Parent, & Student Responsibilities

School Responsibilities

- Implement Continuity of Learning plan & adjust as needed to maintain a student-focused and family-friendly learning experience
- Communicate regularly - Weekly email update on Thursdays
- Support teachers in planning and implementing plans
- Help families find needed resources in the community

Teacher Responsibilities

- Make learning plan for the week available in a timely manner - every Monday 9am
- Provide meaningful learning opportunities & focus on the most essential learning targets
- Communicate regularly with students through live meetings, recorded video, and Seesaw/Google Classroom
- Be available at scheduled times to answer student/caregiver questions
- Provide timely feedback on student
- Track student engagement on a regular basis



Parent Responsibilities

- Check for emails from Ms. Leisa on Thursdays
 - ◆ (If you are not receiving regular emails, please email her at leisa.lobbezoo@innocademy.com)
- Check Bloomz for your elementary child for communication on Mondays (ask questions, share the learning happening in your home, etc.)
- Review work assigned to your child and talk to students about their work every day...website updated every Monday at 9am with plans from teachers
- Ensure that your child is completing remote learning activities as students can earn a “Credit” or “Incomplete”.
- Reserve a space for students to complete remote learning work
- Encourage students to follow some type of regular daily routine where they continue to get enough sleep, have time limits for technology, classwork time, etc.

Student Responsibilities

- Be respectful to yourself, family members, teachers, and peers at all times
- Connect with your teacher during set class time or view recording if unable to make the scheduled live time
- Review assigned work and ask clarifying questions when you need help or don't understand
- Complete your core work each week and enjoy selecting from the challenges and whole child learning options on Fridays
